Eligibility - Contest Rules

The 2010 AirWaves Radio Scholarship Contest is open to students in grades 9 through 12 enrolled in a secondary school. Students under the age of 19 must provide a parent's or legal guardian's signature of consent on the entry form.

Students must research, write and produce a 30-second radio commercial or public service announcement about the effect vehicle emissions have on air quality and health.

The commercials must be no more than 30 seconds in length, including the use of sound effects and music. Students should review the "Top 10 Tips for Writing Radio Commercials" sheet included in the contest information package.

Entries must be recorded either on CD or audio cassette. A hard copy of the script and a clearly marked and signed entry form **MUST** accompany each entry.

Entries must be received at Air Care Colorado, 5175 Marshall St., Arvada, CO, 80002, **no later than 5 p.m. on Monday, February 15, 2010.**

Two winning entries will be selected. Each winning entry will receive a cash scholarship in the amount of \$1,500 and an environmental grant for their school in the amount of \$500.

Students may submit an entry as a team, but the number of students per team is limited to three. In the case that a team submits a winning entry, one scholarship award will be shared equally among the three students. Entries with more than three students listed will not be eligible.

All entries become the property of Air Care Colorado and the Regional Air Quality Council, which reserves the right to use any radio commercial entry in whole or in part for Air Care Colorado/RAQC promotional purposes.

All judges' decisions are final.
